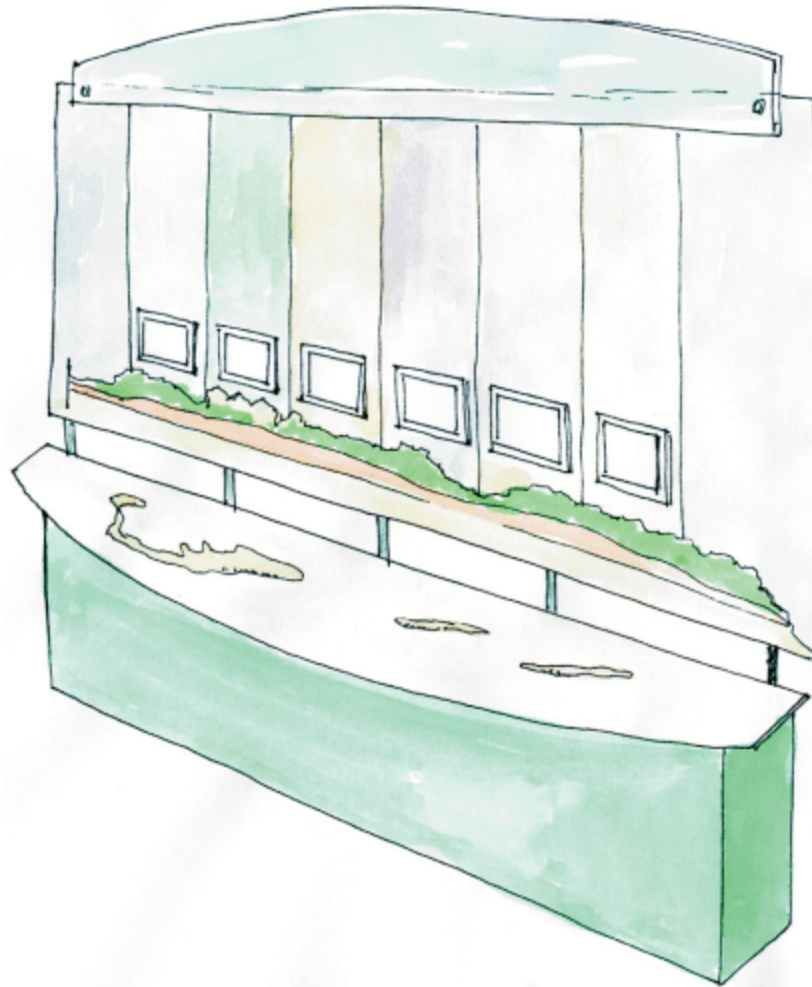
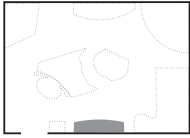


3.4 Natural History Gallery

The wonderful diversity of environments that makes up these isolated islands is portrayed in a striking, large wall-mounted exhibit. This is complemented by an arresting wall-mounted topographic model, beautifully painted and indexed by habits, giving visitors a fascinating three-dimensional view of the islands. In addition, a hand-painted mural of a cross-section of the islands beautifully illustrates each unique habitat, and small wall-mounted specimen cases feature models of key species, such as the wild banana orchid. Pieces of local wood are left uncovered, inviting visitors to feel the differences in grain and texture. Visitors are further engaged by individual, indexed habits featured in changing electronic photo frames.
